The keynote luncheon speaker on Saturday will be Amanda Simpson. Ms. Simpson was Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense at the US Dept. of Defense during the Obama administration. She was recognized as one of the top 50 successful transgender Americans, and was a 2015 AAUW NCCWSL Women of Distinction recipient.

#### **Doris Jones**

Doris was born in 1931 and died November 1, 2016. She earned her bachelor's degree in education minoring in special education from Southern Illinois University and later her master's degree in education with a school administrative endorsement from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. She taught special education and fourth grade before serving as the principal of Carrie Busey Elementary School in Champaign from 1980-1999. Carrie Busey, during her tenure, served as both an elementary school and as the districtwide special education site. In 1990, while Doris was principal, Carrie Busey was nationally recognized as a School of Excellence. Doris served as Co-President of the Champaign-Urbana AAUW Branch from 1999-2001 and, in later years, was a member of the Drama Group.

#### Jean M. Due

Jean was born in 1921 and died November 27, 2016. She earned her BA from the University of Toronto and her MS and Ph.D. from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Jean was an agricultural economist primarily interested in international agriculture specializing in the development economy of East Africa. She traveled to East Africa over the span of 40 years to improve the lives of women through improved agricultural production and microfinancing. She also sponsored African women to come to the U of I as students. Jean was an Honorary Life Member of AAUW, having been a member for over fifty years.
